Our woodland cabins

Our woodland cabins are situated on the doorstep of Ufton's woodlands.

The purpose-built cabins and catering cabin, are perfect for a residential, woodland experience.

The Woodland Cabins

- Accommodation for up to 38 children and 6 adults
- Each cabin sleeps 10 children and 8 children in our adapted cabin
- Ensuite bathrooms
- One teacher or leader's cabin sleeping 6 adults
- Access to extensive woodland and footpaths
- 1 fully equipped accessible cabin with adjustable beds, hoist and shower room
- Central heating
- Communal kitchen and dining cabin
- All bedding provided
- Outdoor recreation areas available











The Longhouse

Our Longhouse treehouse provides an unforgettable camping experience for residential visits.

- Accommodation sleeping 15 28 children and 4 adults
- Communal, mixed gender sleeping
- Roll mats provided for children
- Tents and camp beds are available for Teachers
- Space for additional tents outside for larger groups
- Access to eco-toilet facilities
- Access to extensive woodland and footpaths
- Covered kitchen facilities and seating areas
- Outdoor recreation areas available

Work as a team to climb and conquer the Challenge Wall.


• Low Ropes

Use natural materials to design and build your own simple structures.






Boogie Bash!
